US TERMINOLOGY

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MATERIALS

YARN

- Use same as the yarn you used in the main body of blanket
- Use as many different colors as you want in your border

OTHER MATERIALS

CROCHET HOOK - Same as the one you used in the main body of blanket. Scissors

Yarn Needle

STITCH ABBREVIATIONS

ch(s) | Chain(s)

st(s) | Stitch(es)

slst | Slip Stitch

sc | Single Crochet

hdc | Half Double Crochet

dc | Double Crochet

tr | Treble Crochet

Rnd | Round

INSTRUCTIONS

SI st into the top corner st with first yarn color you want to use for your border. This is just to attach the yarn to the project.

Rnd 1:

sc in the same st you just sl st'd into, sc in each st across the row, in the last st or first corner, make 3 sc in this same st.

- The first sc is the last st for that side
- The second sc is the turning st
- The third sc is the first st on the next side

When working the sides of your blanket, you will make one sc in the side of each row that starts or ends with a sc or a hdc, make 2 sc in the side of every row beginning or ending with a ch 2 or dc, make 3 sc in the side of every row beginning or ending with a ch 3 or tr.

Make 3 sc in the next corner.

You should now be working along the bottom of your blanket or into round 1. Make one sc between each st of row 1.

(Make sure to count your stitches to make sure you have the same count as number of sts in row 1)

Make 3 sc in the next corner.

Work the next side of your blanket the same as you did on the other side of the blanket.

In Corner #4, make 2 sc in the last corner st, then sl st into the top of the first sc to close the round.

Cut yarn leaving a 4 inch long tail. Tie off your work.

Grab your next color. SI st into the same st you just sI st'd into to close round 1.

Rnd 2:

ch 1, hdc in each st,

In each corner look for the 3 st corner, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, make 1 hdc in the third st.

Repeat around.

In corner #4, look for the last 2 sts you made, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, then sl st into the top of the first st to close the round.



Cut yarn leaving a 4 inch long tail. Tie off your work. Grab your next color. SI st into the same st you just sI st'd into to close round 2.

Rnd 3:

ch 1, hdc in each st,

In each corner look for the 3 st corner, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, make 1 hdc in the third st.

Repeat around.

In corner #4, look for the corner 3 sts, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, make 1 hdc in the third st, then sl st into the top of the first st to close the round.



Cut yarn leaving a 4 inch long tail. Tie off your work. Grab your next color. SI st into the same st you just sI st'd into to close round 3.

Rnd 4:

ch 1, hdc in each st,

In each corner look for the 3 st corner, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, make 1 hdc in the third st.

Repeat around.

In corner #4, look for the corner 3 sts, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, make 1 hdc in the third st, make one more hdc, then sl st into the top of the first st to close the round.



Cut yarn leaving a 4 inch long tail. Tie off your work. Grab your next color. SI st into the same st you just sI st'd into to close round 4.

Rnd 5:

ch 1, hdc in each st,

In each corner look for the 3 st corner, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, make 1 hdc in the third st.

Repeat around.

In corner #4, look for the corner 3 sts, make 1 hdc in the first st, make 3 hdc in the second st, make 1 hdc in the third st, make one hdc in the last 2 sts, then sl st into the top of the first st to close the round.



Cut yarn leaving a 4 inch long tail. Tie off your work. Weave in all the ends.
